**STATE FUNERAL FOR THE LATE REAR ADMIRAL
SIR DAVID MARTIN, KCMG, AO**

Premier Nick Greiner today announced a State Funeral will be held for the Late Rear Admiral Sir David Martin, KCMG, AO the former Governor of New South Wales.

The funeral service will be conducted at St Andrew's Cathedral, George Street, Sydney at 11 am on Thursday August 16.

Officiating at the service will be the Anglican Archbishop of Sydney, the Most Rev. Donald Robinson and the Dean of Sydney, the Rt. Rev. Kenneth Short.

The Australian Defence Forces have been requested to participate in the State Funeral.

Sir David Martin's family have requested that no flowers be sent. Instead of floral tributes it is requested that donations be made to the Sir David Martin Foundation, a program for troubled youth administered by the Sydney City Mission.

Following the service the funeral procession will travel north along George Street shortly after noon. A private cremation service will be conducted later in the day.

Detailed plans are being drawn up for the management of traffic in the city before and after the State Funeral service.
